Antoinette Walker is a long time Kodiak resident. After working in oils most of her life she took a mixed medium class. She began using found objects, rusty beach metals, paper, bird feathers, bones, just about anything. Antoinette's encaustic-mixed media art at once captures the yin-yang of her coastal home. Her rich fusions of form and color balance the cool hues and transparency of ocean-bound landscapes with the bold raw energy of Alaska's vibrant fishing ports. Her encaustic paintings, a textured terrain of people and place invite us to look around and find subtle surprise.

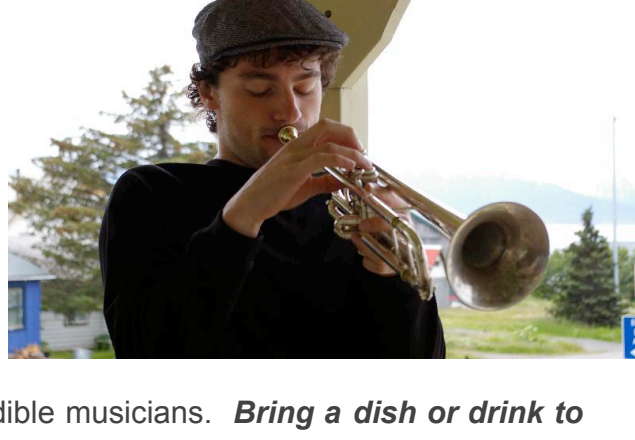
Artist talk, 6pm, Aug 6th



"Oil is once again ever present in the news. This led me to think about all the types of oil humans have used as a part of their daily ritual. These forms are my interpretations of ancient and contemporary vessels. When producing work for a show I always use the opportunity to create new work that is related, but doesn't replicate the production pottery I make on a daily basis. This work is made from Terra Cotta and midrange white clay. My production ware is typically highfire porcelain and stoneware. I have been a full time potter in Alaska since 1980 when living in Sitka."

Alaskan Women Singer/songwriters for Peace

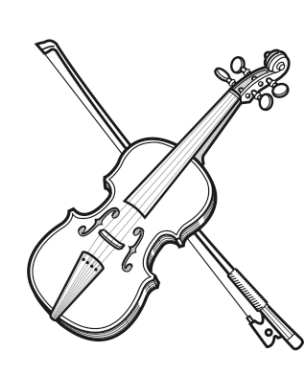

Judy Tuwaletstiwa, Lecture Thursday, August 12th



Visiting artist Judy Tuwaletstiwa combines paint and canvas with sand, clay, fiber and sticks - materials particular to the Black Mesa in Northern Arizona, where she lived for several years on a Hopi reservation. She investigates the embrace of uncharted terrains that open the unconscious. She writes, "In my work, whether writing or painting, I seek a language that embodies the elusive and mysterious images that resonate from the deep strata of the unknown." In addition to Ms. Tuwaletstiwa's international reputation as a painter, she is the recipient of a Lannan Foundation Literary Residency in Marfa, Texas for The Canyon Poem, a limited-edition book published in 1999.
